Let Duluth Vote Plan B: A Ten-Year Facilities Plan designed for quality education in three traditional Duluth School District corridors, featuring one high school campus in each, with an integrated middle school on the same site, and the retention of four existing, neighborhood elementary schools in each corridor. Grade configurations will be changed to match educational programs, promote existing building efficiency, and provide subject choices for students.

Let Duluth Vote successfully petitioned for a special election with the following ballot question:
"Shall the ISD 709 School Board be authorized to issue general obligation bonds totaling \$128,000,000 to be used with an estimated \$66,092,086 in bonds and investment earnings approved by the Board for alternate facilities to build

two new middle schools and

two new elementary schools;

repair and remodel three high schools,

one middle school,

and five elementary schools;

repair and expand two elementary schools;

and repair and remodel "Old Central High" and the

Secondary Technical Center?"

LDV 10-Yr School Facilities Plan: two phases, Phase 1 repairs with and updates 19 schools while maximizing programming, Phase II consolidates to 16 schools, including twelve elementary, grades K-6 and three Jr-Sr high schools, at the end of year 10 (2020). The following new buildings and and new wings would be built by 2020:

Two New Middle School wings (Gds 7 & 8) at Denfeld and East High School sites;

Two new K-6 elementary schools at **Lincoln Park** & **Lester Park** (on Rockridge site)

Three high schools at Denfeld, Central & East High (Grs 9-12)

Ordean Middle School remodeled into an elementary school

Piedmont, **Lowell**, **Nettleton**, **Homecroft**, & **Congdon**,

MacArthur & **Grant** Elementary Schools

Historic DCHS (Unity HS, ALC, Print Shop, Storeroom and Admin Offices)

Remodel STC building into Central Middle School, Gds 7&8

(**Stowe** and **Lakewood** Elementary Schools are complete, no additional work needed.)
